General Requirements

The Norfolk Southern Thoroughbred Sustainability Partner Awards are intended to recognize leaders in (1) corporate programs achieving energy efficiency savings, (2) innovations that have significantly contributed to a more sustainable future, and (3) outstanding efforts promoting stewardship of the environment. There are separate award categories for each of these three topics. You may provide a submission for one, two or all three of the categories. Please submit no more than one nomination per category. If any aspect of your submission is confidential, please mark it as such.

The application period will open on September 11, 2023, and will close on October 6, 2023. Winners will be selected based on a committee comprised of Norfolk Southern marketing, sourcing, and environmental representatives. Winners will be announced December 2023 and a winner's celebration will be held in Q1 2024.

Eligibility

Eligibility is as follows:

- Applicants must be from Norfolk Southern's current customers and suppliers.
- Only results which include measurable progress in 2022 are eligible.
- Submissions should be based on transportation industry-relevant achievements.
